The MIII Creek Cougars are one of the fastest growing youth tackle football and cheer programs in the Puget Sound. Founded in 2024 with just 1 team of 24 players, the Cougars now have 5 teams with over 100 registered tackle football players and cheerleaders.



In order to compete in our new league, the top priority of our program will be to develop each of our player's MIND, BODY, and SPIRIT, to safely and aggressively face the challenge of playing tackle football at a high level, enabling them to reap lifelong rewards from that process.
